

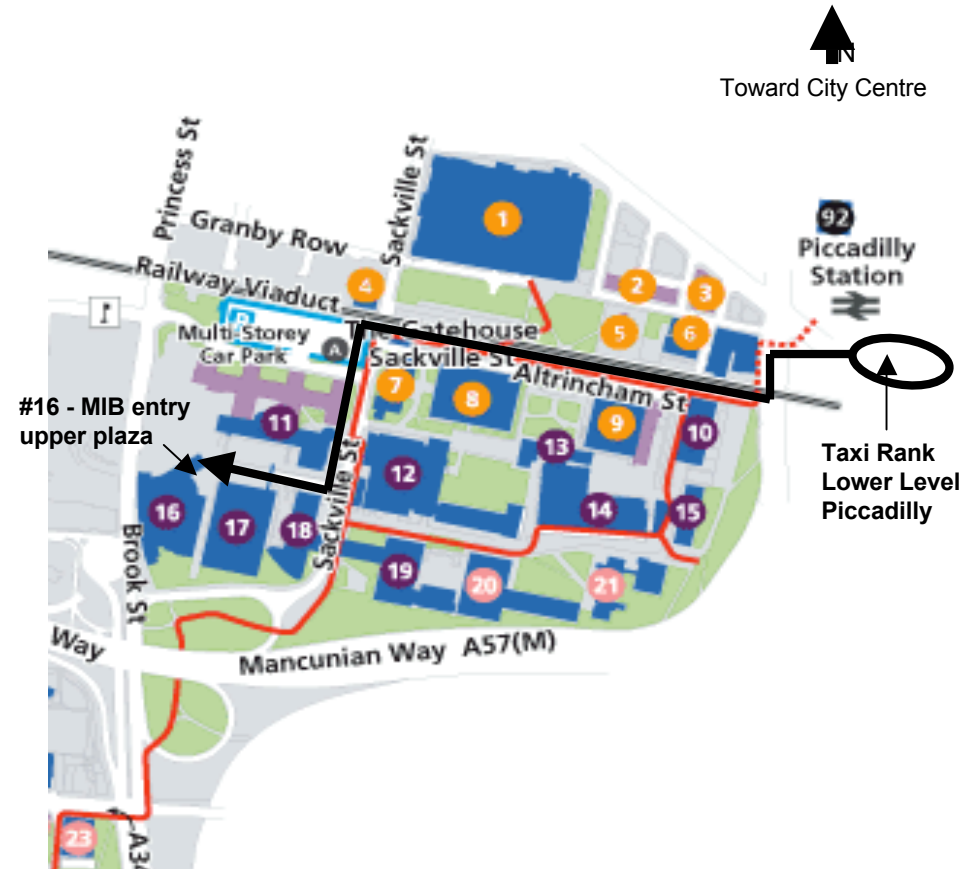
AIA UK & Continental Europe

For those people coming up to Manchester early on Saturday morning it is possible to proceed directly to the 9am **Lecture and Building tour at the University of Manchester MIB**. The building is approximately 5 minutes from Piccadilly Station. Directions on how to get directly from the train station to the MIB are to the left.

9:00 – 10:30

Lecture and Building Tour 1.5 LUs (HSW and SD)

Building tour of the Manchester Interdisciplinary Biocentre (MIB) designed by Anshen Dyer. At this venue there will also be a presentation by Woods Bagot on the Piccadilly Tower that when complete is claimed to be the tallest residential/hotel in Europe. Participants to meet at the MIB building for 9:00 am or alternately a group will leave Urbis at 8:45.



DIRECTIONS (black line above)

Upon arrival at Piccadilly Station turn left on entry to the main hall from the platform, continue down two sets of escalators to the Taxi Rank, exit and turn right toward London Road (only 20 metres away). At London Road turn left, under rail viaduct, take right onto Altrincham to Sackville, turn left. The ramp to an elevated plaza is off Sackville between the Faraday Tower and Weston Hall. Turn right up the ramp and proceed forward to the Manchester Interdisciplinary Biocentre (MIB). Total travel time is just over 5 minutes.
